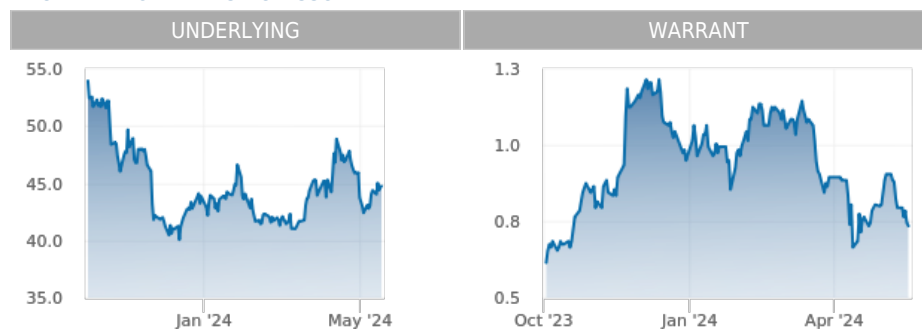

DESCRIPTION
